Our *Name That Animal* program is an opportunity for young “scientists” to see, touch, and hear animals that they have read about in books, watched on TV, or seen at the zoo or in the wild.

Scientists will:
Examine skins
Identify animals
Observe adaptations

During this experience the scientists will see a variety of skins from the different animal groups: reptiles, amphibians, fish, birds, and mammals. They will name the animal from the skin or its picture and then get to feel with their “whiskers”. As a scientist, they will learn about each animal’s habitat and what it has on its menu. They will also get to hear some of the different sounds the animals might make in the wild.

Reservation and Overview

To make reservations for a 30-45 minute *Name That Animal* program, call the office with dates in mind and the approximate number of participants. Contract information will be sent; have the participants return the “A Letter for Parents” On the day(s) of your programs, our instructor will arrive 15 minutes prior to the first class to assemble the materials to be used for the program.
