



A Checklist for Science Eye Safari Campers

What to Bring?

- ✓ Water bottle (reusable - we are eco-friendly)
- ✓ Lunch (optional - lunch is provided daily by Science Eye)
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Bandana (to wet and put around neck when it is hot out)
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Bug spray
- ✓ Rain jacket/poncho depending on the weather (not bad to keep in camper's backpack)
- ✓ *Optional: Camera*
Optional: Binoculars

What NOT to Bring?

- ✓ Electronics: Gameboy, ipod, etc. (digital cameras ok; cell phones are ok if turned off and remain in backpacks unless they are being used as cameras ONLY)
- ✓ Money (they do not need any, unless they want it for field trips)
- ✓ Valuables (backpacks will remain in the room or at the field site)

The instructors will be arriving about 30 minutes before camp begins. Therefore children cannot be dropped off earlier. Aftercare ends at 5pm, children need to be picked up by 5pm.

Due to the location of camp this year, campers need to be dropped off at the SPHS Magnet building towards the back of the school. BCPS are closed on Fridays. Therefore, on Fridays campers need to be dropped off & picked up at the front of the school. We will be on a field trip the entire day on Fridays.
